Menggapai Pelangi is a financial assistance program designed to support children with cancer who need to travel for clinical trials –especially when no other treatment options are available. Eligibility for this support must be confirmed and endorsed by the child’s oncology doctor.

Clinical trials are medical experiments being conducted to find better ways to treat or manage diseases like cancer.

Who?

It is meant for the children with cancer, and their 2 family members. The child has to have exhausted all medical treatments available in Singapore.

How?

The scheme covers essential expenses such as accommodation, flights, visa fees, and a daily food allowance. However, it does not include the cost of medical treatment.

Why?

When caregivers are informed that their child are no longer responding to any treatment and are at the end of life, parents don't and won't stop hoping for a cure. They all wish they can do more. Ain Society comes in to offer a final option in the form of any clinical trials, to help parents know that they have tried everything they can, and no stones are left unturned.

Where?

These trials often take place in hospitals or research centers, and families may need to travel far from home. That's where Menggapai Pelangi steps in to ease the financial burden and make sure distance or cost doesn't stand in the way of a child getting potentially life-saving care.
