- 2010 – Launch of Clubskidz

Officiated by Prof Fatimah Lateef, who continues to serve as Ain Society's medical advisor.

- 2020 – Revamp of Ain Society @ Eunus  
Transformed into a dedicated centre for children with cancer. The launch was officiated by the Eight President of Singapore, Mdm Halimah Yacob.
- 2023 – Opening of Adolescents and Young Adult (AYA) Care at YHCC

Officially launched by our Patron, Mdm Halimah Yacob, to expand support for young people with cancer.

Young Heroes Cancer Care supports children with cancer, their siblings, and families. Most cases are walk-ins or referred by hospitals and partner organizations.

#### 01. Children Play Area
